
In FLAT Keys, the LAST b in the Key Signature is "Fa", or the 4th note of the scale. Count down "4-3-2-1" or "Fa-Mi-Re-Do" to find DO, which is the name of the Major Key



In SHARP Keys, the LAST # in the Key Signature is "Ti", or the next-to-last note of the scale. Go *upward* to the very next line or space, and that is the name of the Major Key

## **Examples:**

- **♪** There are 4 *Flats* ~ The LAST *flat* is "G-flat". This is D FLAT Major
- ↑ There are 5 Sharps ~ The LAST sharp is "A-sharp". This is B Major. (Not B-flat!)
